
Response Rate Since 2012








1. When did you start looking for a job?

Before Graduation (month)













2. How did you look for your first job after graduation?





3. How many months did you spend before/after graduation to seek your first job?


Before Graduation (month)






3. How many months did you spend before/after graduation to seek your first job?

After Graduation (month)






4. How many companies/institution did you contact before you got your first job?





5. How many employers responded to your apllication?












Income From Current Major Job (in thousands)

Income From Overtime and Extra Payment Major Job (in thousands)









Conclusions

- The new way to contact alumnies then send the link questionnaire directly is more effectively to increase the response rate.
- Just 8,33 % from total alumnies cohort 2013 that already worked. Beside that, 30,56 % still looking for a employment.
- The 5th highest gaps in competencies are working independently, communication, adaptability, loyalty & integrity, and initiative.
